

NIE Energy Commercial LED Lighting Offer: Conditions and Criteria

The following conditions will be applied to applications for the NIE Energy Commercial LED Lighting grant:

- Grant must be used to support the capital costs of LED lighting. As a general rule this includes only the equipment itself.
- Scheme must be located within Northern Ireland.
- The application form must be completed in full and signed by the applicant.
- **You must be in receipt of a grant offer letter from NIE Energy before proceeding with any work.** NIE Energy will not provide a grant for those who have proceeded with the work without having applied to NIE Energy and having received a NIE Energy grant offer letter. There will be no exceptions to this requirement.
- LEDs must meet the LED Guidelines which can be found at www.nie-yourenergy.co.uk/business.
- Grants are only available for the purchase of new LEDs.
- Only one application will be permitted per commercial building with a maximum of one grant overall.
- Grants must be claimed within 3 months of a grant offer being made by NIE Energy.
- Applicants must allow access to the LED installation for inspection purposes by the scheme manager (or other appointed by the scheme manager) if required – random installation checks will be carried out.
- Applicants benefiting from an NIE Energy grant may be requested to participate in promotional activity e.g. a photograph. Participation may not unreasonably be refused.
- Payment of the grant will only be made on **receipt of a completed grant claim form and invoices** to NIE Energy.
- By signing the application form you agree to the grant terms and conditions.
- It is your responsibility to inform NIE Energy of any changes to your installation (including any change to the specific type of LEDs installed) because it may impact upon your entitlement to receive a grant.
- If you require an extension to your grant offer then you must inform NIE Energy as soon as possible so that a revised grant offer can be issued.
- NIE Energy reserves the right to refuse applications.
